CORBIÈRES ROUGE CHÂTEAU HAUTE-FONTAINE

LANGUEDOC, FRANCE

Produced from an English owned vineyard near Narbonne, this wine typifies the more experimental approach to wine making of this region. Blended from Grenache, Syrah and Carignan grapes; rich aromas of cassis and herbs lead to complex forest fruits, leather and tobacco flavours.

JEWEL OLD VINE ZINFANDEL
LODI, CALIFORNIA, USA

Made from grapes picked from vines with an average age of 60 years this outstanding example of California's indigenous wine is deep in colour with enticing fruit filled aromas and generous flavours of dark berries, black currants and vanilla.

TABALI SPECIAL RESERVE PINOT NOIR

LIMARI VALLEY, CHILE

From an excellent producer in the northern Limari Valley, much admired by The Torygraph's wine writer Jonathan Ray, a deep cherry coloured wine with red currant and strawberry aromas. Intense and elegant with soft tannins from 15 months ageing in French oak.

CORONA de CASTILLO ESTILO

RIBERO DEL DUERO, SPAIN

From one of Spain's premier wine regions and barrel aged for 6 months in American and French oak, intense red berry fruits combine harmoniously with vanilla and liquorice notes to produce a deep coloured, firm flavoured wine.
